- (1) Within 45 days <u>after filing</u> the **Fictitious Business Name Statement of Abandonment** with the County Clerk, the registrant shall publish the statement in an adjudicated newspaper once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks. <u>File</u> an affidavit of publication with the County Clerk within 45 days after publication has been accomplished. The statement should be published in an adjudicated newspaper that circulates in the area where the business was conducted. (Sec. 17917 B&P Code)
- (2) Any person who executes, files, or publishes any statement (as defined by the Business and Professional Code), knowing that such statement is false, in whole or in part, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000). (Section 17930 B&P Code)
